**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF FORTSON OIL COMPANY
FOR INCREASED GAS/OIL RATIO AUTHORITY
FOR THE GODFREY UNIT LEASE WELL NO. 1
TRIPLE HEAT (PALO PINTO) FIELD
JONES COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on March 22, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Fortson Oil Company be and is hereby granted permission to produce the Godfrey Unit Lease Well No.1, Triple Heat (Palo Pinto) Field, Jones County, Texas, under increased gas-oil ratio authority with a daily gas limit of 225 MCF. The MER for the Fortson Oil Company Godfrey Unit Lease Well No. 1 is 125 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Fortson Oil Company Godfrey Unit Lease Well No. 1 in the Triple Heat (Palo Pinto) Field be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.
