**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF SANDALWOOD OIL & GAS, INC.
FOR INCREASED GAS-OIL RATIO
FOR THE WELDER D LEASE WELL NO. 4
FOR THE PORTILLA (7000-B-SAND) FIELD
SAN PATRICIO COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 29, 1999, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Sandalwood Oil & Gas, Inc. be and is hereby granted permission to produce its Welder D Lease Well No. 4 in the Portilla (7000-B-Sand) Field, San Patricio County, Texas, under increased gas-oil ratio authority with a daily gas limit of 500 MCF.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Sandalwood Oil & Gas, Inc., Welder D Lease Well No. 4 in the Portilla (7000-B-Sand) Field be and is hereby canceled.
