**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
DEVON ENERGY PRODUCTION CO. LP
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32
FOR THE GAILAN LEASE
SPRABERRY (TREND AREA) FIELD
MIDLAND COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 15, 2014, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Devon Energy Production Co. LP is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Gailan Lease, Spraberry (Trend Area) Field, Midland County, Texas. Devon Energy Production Co. LP is authorized to flare a maximum of 475 MCF per day of casinghead gas, or a total flared volume of 24,934 MCF from the Gailan Lease, from September 5, 2014 through November 7, 2014. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
