In addition to the rules and regulations stated above, the applicable option associated with Rule 31. Measurements and Adjustments will apply: Option 1 – Loss allowance of 0.2% except that there shall be no loss allowance for crude oil received at Hainesville, Wood County, Texas.

EXCEPTIONS TO PLAINS PIPELINE, L.P.'S TEXAS RRC NO. 70:

In lieu of the \$0.0692 special handling charge for truck unloading stated in Rule 43 of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Texas RRC No. 70, supplements thereto or reissues thereof, where trucks are unloaded on Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s main line, a special handling charge of [C] cents per barrel will be added to the trunk line rate in effect.
