During the 89th Legislature of Texas, the Legislature passed SB 494, wherein the Railroad Commission of Texas now has jurisdiction to form a theft of petroleum products task force. Therefore, the State Taskforce on Petroleum Theft (STOPTHEFT) is established within the Railroad Commission to study and make recommendations relating to the study of the theft of petroleum products in the state, review laws and regulations addressing the theft of petroleum products, and make recommendations regarding the theft of petroleum product outreach including training for law enforcement officers and prosecutors on effective strategies for combating the theft of petroleum products.
