FINAL ORDER

APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF STEWARD ENERGY II, LLC FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 TO FLARE CASINGHEAD GAS FOR THE BACKSLIDER 582 LEASE, NEVERMIND 451 LEASE, BANJO BILL 452 LEASE, MOONDANCE 534 LEASE, PLANTANG (SAN ANDRES) FIELD, YOAKUM COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numerated docket heard on November 30, 2017, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application submitted by Steward Energy II, LLC is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Steward Energy II, LLC is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Backslider 582 Lease, Nevermind 451 Lease, Banjo Bill 452 Lease, and the Moondance 534 Lease, Plantang (San Andres) Field, Yoakum County, Texas.. Steward is authorized to flare a maximum volume of 800 mcf/d of casinghead gas from the Backslider 582 Lease, 700 mcf/d from the Nevermind 451 Lease, 3,000 mcf/d from the Banjo Bill 452 Lease and 800 mcf/d from the Moondance 534 Lease for a period of two years from November 12, 2017 through November 12, 2019. The authority is granted provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. Steward Energy II, LLC shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
