APPLYING ON THE INTRASTATE TRANSPORTATION BY PIPELINE OF
CRUDE PETROLEUM

The rates named in this tariff are for trunk line transportation and the gathering of Crude Petroleum by pipelines, subject to the Rules and Regulations published in Plains Pipeline L.P.'s Texas R.R.C. No. 70.12.0 and reissues thereof ("Rules and Regulations Tariff").

EFFECTIVE: April 13, 2018

The provisions published herein will, if effective, not result in an effect on the quality of the human environment.

⁽¹⁾ **Committed Volume Rate:** The committed volume rates contained herein are contract rates available to any Shipper who executes a contract for the transportation of a minimum of 100,000 barrels per day for a period of ten (10) years.

Pumpover Charge: There will be a pumpover receipt charge of [U] 15.53 cents per barrel for barrels received from Rangeland at Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Midland South, Midland County, Texas.

EXCEPTIONS TO PLAINS PIPELINE, L.P.'S RULES AND REGULATIONS TARIFF:

[W] Rule 40A: In addition to the quality specifications stated in Rule 40A of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Rules and Regulations Tariff, the following quality specifications will apply:

- a. API gravity shall not exceed 44.0°.
- b. The sulfur content for WTI crude shall not exceed 0.45% by weight.

[W] Rule 25C: In lieu of the nomination date provisions stated in Rule 25C of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Rules and Regulations Tariff, the following will apply: Any Shipper desiring to tender Crude Petroleum for transportation shall make a Nomination to the Carrier before 12:00 noon Central Standard Time/Central Daylight Saving Time, whichever is applicable, on the fifteenth (15th) of the month preceding the movement. When the fifteenth (15th) of the month falls on a weekend, nominations will be required prior to 12:00 noon Central Standard Time/Central Daylight Saving Time, whichever is applicable, on the preceding Business Day. When the fifteenth (15th) of the month falls on a Carrier Holiday, nominations will be required prior to 12:00 noon Central Standard Time/Central Daylight Saving Time, whichever is applicable, three (3) Business Days prior to the Carrier Holiday. Unless such notification is made, the Carrier will be under no obligation to accept Crude Petroleum for transportation.

[N] Rule 85C (2): In addition to the New Shipper allocation provisions stated in Rule 85C (2) of Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Rules and Regulations Tariff, the following will apply: If such pro rata allocation in a given month does not result in all New Shippers being allocated the monthly minimum volume set forth in Rule 25A of Carrier's Rules and Regulations Tariff (the "Minimum Nomination Allocation"), then Carrier will administer a lottery process in order to allocate the 5% of capacity available to New Shippers under Rule 85(C) (2). Detailed procedures regarding Carrier's lottery process are set forth below.

Lottery Process

- a. Carrier will use a software-generated random number process to randomly assign each New Shipper a number from one to the number representing the total number of New Shippers participating in the lottery (i.e. if there are thirty New Shippers, numbers one through thirty will be assigned).

- b. The New Shipper assigned number one will receive the first Minimum Nomination Allocation. Thereafter, Minimum Nomination Allocations will be assigned to New Shippers sequentially, from the lowest assigned number to the highest assigned number, until the 5% of available capacity referenced in Rule 85C (2) of Carrier's Rules and Regulations Tariff is fully allocated.
- c. Following the lottery, Carrier will notify New Shippers as to whether or not they were allocated capacity in that month.
