**APPROVING THE APPLICATION SEABOARD OPERATING CO FOR AN EXCEPTION TO
STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR THE CONDOR LEASE, NEWSON (YATES) FIELD, GAINES
COUNTY, TEXAS**

FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numerated docket heard on September 24, 2018, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required that the proposed application submitted by Seaboard Operating Company is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Seaboard Operating Co is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 (Permit No. 25268) for its Condor Lease (No. 69609) in the Newson (Yates) Field, Gaines County, Texas. Seaboard Operating Co is hereby authorized to flare up to 180 thousand cubic feet (mcf) of gas per day from the Condor Lease from August 17, 2018, to August 16, 2020.

The authority is granted provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. Seaboard Operating Company shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
