Routing for Joint Rates in Table Above

ExxonMobil Pipeline Company LLC (“ExxonMobil”) pipeline system from ExxonMobil Refinery, Baytown, Texas to an interconnection with NuStar Logistics, L.P.’s (“NuStar”) pipeline system at NuStar Baytown Junction, then on NuStar’s pipeline system from NuStar Baytown Junction to an interconnection with ExxonMobil’s pipeline system at NuStar South Houston Junction, then on ExxonMobil’s pipeline system at NuStar South Houston Junction to ExxonMobil South Houston Terminal, Harris County, Texas.

Exceptions to the currently effective tariff in NuStar Logistics, L.P.’s Rules and Regulations Texas No. 112 series or subsequent reissues thereof: For purposes of this tariff, the following definition is changed from Item 1 (Definitions) of the governing Rules and Regulations tariff:

“Carrier” shall mean (a) ExxonMobil, while a Shipper’s Products are being transported on ExxonMobil’s portion of the joint movement specified herein, and (b) NuStar, while a Shipper’s Products are being transported on NuStar’s portion of the joint movement, except that “Carrier” shall mean NuStar with respect to Item 4, Item 9, and Item 12.
