FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on July 30, 2018, the Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that A.C.T. Operating Company is hereby granted an authority to consolidate the Roullain L.S. et. al. (03895) and St. Clair (03900) Lease into the Morton Unit (70422) and approval of secondary recovery operations on the Morton Unit, Levelland Field, Cochran County, Texas.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the consent of the applicant, the Final Order is final and effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
