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**APPLICATION OF WPX ENERGY PERMIAN, LLC (942623) FOR AN EXCEPTION TO  
STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR THE HATTIE 3 CENTRAL FLARE POINT, PHANTOM  
(WOLFCAMP) FIELD, REEVES COUNTY, TEXAS**

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**FINAL ORDER**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on March 26, 2019 the presiding Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that WPX Energy Permian, LLC (942632), Inc. is hereby granted an a two-year Statewide Rule 32 exception authority to flare a maximum of 1,800 thousand cubic feet per day of gas well gas from the Hattie 3 Central Flare Point (Commingling Permit No. 8684) extending from March 2, 2019 to March 2, 2021 (Flare Permit No. 34344), as reflected in Attachment A, attached and made a part hereof.

This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. WPX Energy Permian, LLC shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for each flare point.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and by agreement of the parties in writing or on the record, **the parties have waived the right to file a motion for rehearing and the Final Order in this case is final and effective on the date the Master Order relating to the Final Order is signed.**
