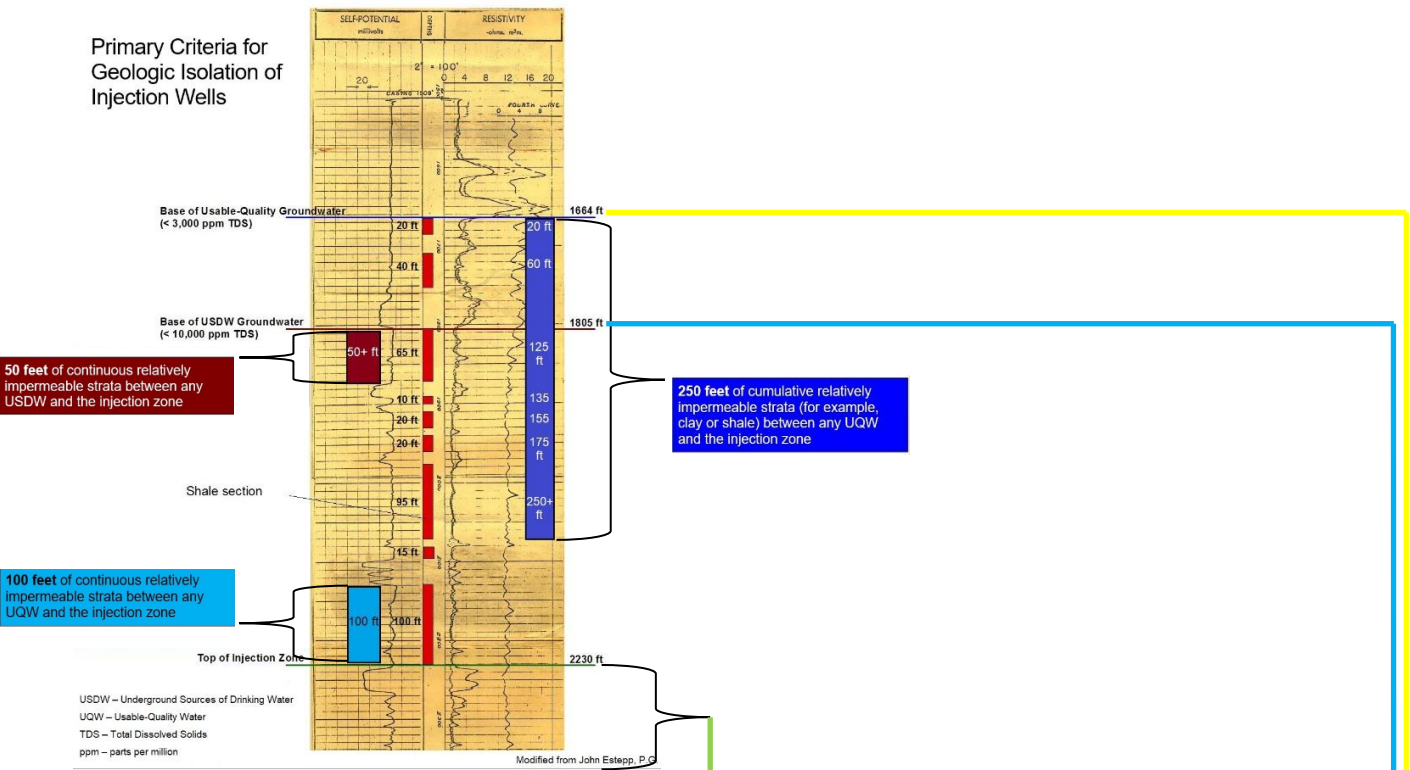

The base of usable-quality water-bearing strata is estimated to occur at a depth of 1664 feet at the site of the referenced well.		
The BASE OF UNDERGROUND SOURCES OF DRINKING WATER (USDW) is estimated to occur at a depth of 1805 feet at the site of the referenced well.		
This recommendation is applicable to all wells within a radius of 200 feet of this location.		
Note: Unless stated otherwise, this recommendation is intended to apply only to the subject well and not for area-wide use. Unless stated otherwise, this recommendation is for normal drilling, production, and plugging operations only.

Dear Mr. Harcourt:

This letter is in response to your referenced application for a Railroad Commission of Texas permit to dispose of oil and gas waste into strata in the depth interval from 2,235 feet to 4,100 feet. Our review of the data contained in the application and of other available geologic data indicates, if otherwise compliant with Railroad Commission of Texas rules and guidelines, that drilling and using this disposal well and injecting oil and gas waste into the subsurface stratum will not endanger the freshwater strata in that area.

The base of usable-quality groundwater occurs to a depth of approximately 1,664 feet in accordance with GAU Letter No. 296480. The base of the Underground Source of Drinking Water (USDW) is estimated to be 1,805 feet.
