## NOTICE TO OIL AND GAS AND PIPELINE OPERATORS

### Tropical Weather Outlook

The National Weather Service is projecting a tropical weather system that could impact several parts of East and Southeast Texas, resulting in heavy rainfall over the next several days. The system could bring 9-13" or even more of rainfall if the tropical system stalls. The chance of tropical weather development remains high.

The RRC advises all operators under the RRC's jurisdiction in areas of potential impact to take the following actions:

- Monitor local, state and national weather reports for updates on potential severe weather impacts;
- Heed all watches, warnings and orders issued by local emergency officials;
- Secure all personnel, equipment and facilities to prevent injury or damage; and,
- Monitor and prepare operations for potential impacts, as safety permits.

The RRC maintains a 24-hour, toll-free emergency line, 844-773-0305, to report emergencies, including leaks or spills and damage to gas pipelines.
