Reference: Chapter 4 Division 10 §4.193(e)

IMPORTANT

Before this form can be processed, the facility operator must have on file in the Commission's Austin office a current Form P-5 Organization Report.

The disposal system operator must have a Commission disposal permit for each system listed.

WHO MUST FILE THE WH-3

A person who transports oil & gas waste for hire by any method other than by pipeline off a lease, unit, or other oil & gas property for disposal is required to have a waste hauler permit per §4.193 (a).

COMPLETING THE WH-3

Form WH-3 **WASTE HAULER** fills in the three rows below the title. The **FACILITY OPERATOR** completes the rest of the form and returns it to the waste hauler operator, who will file it with the Commission.

WHAT TO FILE
CHANGE OF FACILITY
OPERATOR

The hauler must file a Form WH-3 for each unique facility operator organization. If there is a change in the facility organization, a new form WH-3 must be filed.

CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY

The facility organization should notify the Commission in Austin in writing when a hauler's authority to use a particular system is cancelled.
