6. Nominations and Proration

A Term Shipper must submit its monthly nomination in accordance with the provisions of Item 45 of **[W]** MPL's <u>currently effective</u> F.E.R.C. No. 158-24.0 and/or Texas No. 49-14.0, supplements thereto and reissues thereof and specify the amount Term Shipper will move under its Total Reserved Capacity Commitment. This nomination will establish its **Final Monthly Reserved Capacity**.

The Final Monthly Reserved Capacity shall not be subject to prorationing except in the event Carrier is rendered unable to transport said nomination because of an event of Force Majeure.

- If Term Shipper's Final Monthly Reserved Capacity is less than its Total Reserved Capacity Commitment, then the short fall volume capacity that Term Shipper elected not to use will be included in the total monthly space available for spot shippers.
- If a Term Shipper's Final Monthly Reserved Capacity exceeds its Total Reserved Capacity Commitment, then the Term Shipper's Final Monthly Reserved Capacity will equal its Total Reserved Capacity Commitment for the month. The portion of volume in excess of Term Shipper's Total Reserved Capacity Commitment will be deemed to have been nominated as a "spot shipper" under the provisions of **[W]** MPL's <u>currently effective</u> F.E.R.C. No. 158-24-0 or Texas No. 49-14-0, supplements thereto and reissues thereof, and will be subject to proration as stated in Item 50 of the applicable tariff. Additionally, the volume in excess of Term Shipper's Total Reserved Capacity Commitment will be shipped under the Base Rate.
- 7. Any deficiency of Term Shipper in meeting its Total Reserved Capacity Commitment shall be governed by the terms of the VCA.
- 8. Carrier will invoice the Term Shipper at the rates set out in Paragraph 5 of this item, at the time of shipment.
- In addition to the terms and conditions contained in this item, all applicable charges, rules and regulations in [W] MPL's <u>currently effective</u> F.E.R.C. No. 158-24.0, and/or Texas No. 49-14.0, supplements thereto and reissues thereof, shall apply.

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[C] Note1: Any movements from the Origin of Pasadena, TX will only have reserved capacity on the route from MPL East Houston, TX, Pasadena (MVP), TX and/or Galena Park, TX to the El Paso (MPL), TX area.

[W] Note <u>12</u>: Any movements from Carrier's Origins defined in Item 200, <u>of currently effective</u> F.E.R.C No. 161.42.0, any supplement thereto and reissues thereof, are considered by Carrier as a reversal of the normal product flow and will only be made upon request by Term Shipper and upon Carrier's determination that such movement can operationally and efficiently be made to accommodate Term Shipper's request. Any such movement permitted by Carrier from Carrier's Origins defined in Item 200, <u>of currently effective</u> F.E.R.C No. 161.42.0, any supplement thereto and reissues thereof, will only have reserved capacity on the route from Frost, TX to the listed Destinations (except as provided in Note <u>78</u>).

[W] Note <u>2</u>3: Deliveries of NEP Grade Product to this Destination require segregated storage in volume equivalent to Term Shipper's ten-day supply needs pursuant to a separate written agreement.

[W] Note <u>34</u>: Deliveries of Arizona Grade Product to this Destination require segregated storage in volume equivalent to Term Shipper's ten-day supply needs pursuant to a separate written agreement.
