Summary

The RRC proposes the repeals, new rules, and amendments to implement House Bill (HB) 5629 (89th Legislature, Regular Session, 2025) which amended Occupations Code §§55.004, 55.0041, 55.0042, 55.005, and 55.009 and Senate Bill (SB) 1818 (89th Legislature, Regular Session, 2025) which amended Occupations Code §§55.004 and 55.0041. The legislation amends current law governing state agencies that issue occupational licenses to military service members, military veterans, and military spouses, establishing new and streamlined requirements.
