Recordkeeping Reminder: In accordance with Rule §4.191(c), generators, haulers, and receivers must retain waste records for at least three years from the shipment date.



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A generator may use this form or another waste manifest to meet the documentation requirements of **16 TAC Chapter 4 Subchapter A Division 10 §4.191**. For waste shipments from or to unattended locations, the generator or receiver may designate a third party to sign the certification on behalf of the generator or receiver. The generator or receiver shall retain evidence of the delegated authorization to sign on its behalf.

SECTION I. WASTE DESCRIPTION

Generator Organization Name / P-5 Number: Enter the legal name of the organization generating the oil and gas waste, and provide the Railroad Commission of Texas P-5 number for the organization.

Contact Information: Provide the name, title, email, and phone number of the primary contact responsible for this waste form.

Generator Facility Name: Enter the official name of the facility where the waste is generated.

Commercial or Non-Commercial: Select the appropriate box to indicate whether the generator is a commercial or non-commercial waste management facility.

Provide one or more of the following site identifiers: Lease Name and Number, and the County where waste is generated. If there is no Lease Number, provide the Gas Plant Number, API Number, and Geographic Coordinates (latitude/longitude in decimal degrees using NAD83). If these do not apply, use the "Other Identifier" field and specify the Commingle Permit Number or another unique Operator Name/RRC Identifier.

Waste Profile ID – The unique identifier assigned by the generator to this waste stream for tracking purposes.

Waste Type – Describe the waste type that is being transported. Refer to the table below for the categories of waste that can be transported and select the relevant waste types that correspond to the load.

Note: Commercial Facility Waste refers to waste generated from a type of waste facility that will be identified on the Waste Manifest Form EP-10.

RCRA E&P Exempt: Indicate "Yes" or "No" based on whether the waste is exempt under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).

Waste Type Quantity: Enter the total volume or weight of waste.

Units of Measure: Use appropriate units such as Gallons (G), Barrels (bbl), Cubic Yards (CY), or specify other units.

NORM: Select the checkbox **ONLY** if NORM exceeds 50µR/hr and enter the measurement in the space provided.

Note: RRC Waste Haulers are NOT authorized to haul NORM waste. The Texas Department of State Health Services has jurisdiction for NORM waste transportation.

Out-of-State Waste: If applicable, indicate the U.S. state where the waste was generated.

Date of Shipment: Enter the date the oil and gas waste was shipped from the facility to the receiver.

SECTION II. GENERATOR CERTIFICATION

Generator Certification – Review the declaration, verify that all information provided is correct, and sign and date the form.



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SECTION III. HAULER'S ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT OF MATERIALS

Hauler Organization Name – Provide the name of the authorized organization transporting the oil and gas waste.

Waste Hauler Permit Number – Provide the authorized waste hauler permit number. The waste hauler must have a current permit from the Railroad Commission of Texas to be able to haul the waste to the receiver's facility.

Hauler Certification – Review the declaration, verify that all information provided is correct, and then sign and date the form.

Discrepancy – The hauler will select the type of discrepancy if one is found.

Discrepancy Details – Include details regarding the cause of the inconsistency in the waste collected by the hauler.

SECTION IV. RECEIVER'S ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT OF MATERIALS

Receiver Facility Name / Facility Permit No.: Include the name and permit number of the receiving facility.

Date and Time of Acceptance – Provide the date and time the waste was received at the facility.

Disposal Certification – Review the declaration, verify that all information provided is correct, then sign and date the form.

Acceptance testing – If applicable, determine if the waste stream has passed the paint filter test and record the NORM reading.

Discrepancy – The disposal facility will select the type of discrepancy if one is found.

Discrepancy Details – Include details regarding the cause of the inconsistency in the waste delivered to the facility.
